# **Standardized Testing-Iowa Tests**

While it is not required in the state of Illinois, many homeschool families choose to participate in testing as a means to check on the progress of their students. Testing them also gives them the opportunity to experience the "testing environment" prior to taking college entrance exams.

For several years, Heritage has proudly provided this service to Heritage families with students Grade 3-12. This opportunity is also open to homeschool families outside of Heritage.

#### How do I order tests?

Parents will order their own test materials for their students, but send them to me. I am registered on the BJU website as a test administrator, so you may search for my name and select me as your administrator. Using my name (Christine Dille) as the Test Administrator will insure that your materials will be sent to me directly. The administrator number that you will use at the checkout is <a href="1649324">1649324</a>. Space is limited, so please let me know soon if you plan to test with us.

What test do I order? The lowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS) for the grade that your child is in currently for the 2016-2017 school year. It should say "Iowa Assessments Form E-Grade \_\_\_\_". Please note that we offer testing for students in grades 3-12 only.

#### What are the costs?

- Purchase of your testing materials \$30 per test)
- · Proctor's fee \$25 per student paid to your administrator on the first day of testing

### When do I need to order by?

In order to ensure that I receive your testing materials on time, you must order by April 15th.

## When will I get results of the test?

You will receive the results of the tests 2-4 weeks after they are administered. The results will come to your home. I am more than happy to meet with parents and discuss the results to help you better understand how to interpret the findings.
